

# Dickinson Refinery

## Fact Sheet



### REFINERY INFORMATION

Located four miles west of Dickinson, N.D. on approximately 318 acres, the Dickinson Refinery is the first refinery in the U.S. to be built in over 30 years. The refinery has a capacity of 20,000 barrels per day (bpd) and primarily processes domestic crude oil from North Dakota delivered by pipeline. The facility manufactures ultra-low sulfur diesel, naphtha and resid, which is marketed to local customers and utilized for further processing in Andeavor's integrated value chain system.

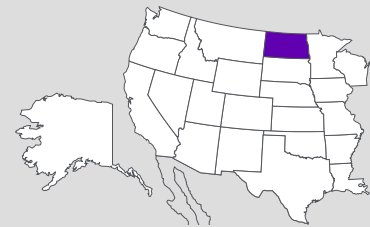
